TILDEN DRAMA BEHAVIOR CONTRACT

Tilden Drama (TD) is a group of Tilden Middle School Students (and the adults who support them) who work together to produce public performances for the benefit of the community in which they live. The Cast, Crew, and adult members of TD form a voluntary collective dedicated to supporting one another, sharing our talents and skills, and teaching and learning from each other. This document outlines the behavioral norms and standards of conduct expected from TD members.

- TD members are expected to support one another at all times.
- TD members treat everyone with kindness and respect. Cliques, bullying, shunning, or harassment of any kind will never be tolerated.
- TD is a highly collaborative effort and, therefore, members are expected to share what they learn with each other. TD is as much about teaching and learning as it is about performing.
- TD Cast and Crew are given specific work assignments, locations, and notification as to which adults will be in charge of each location at the beginning of each after-school activity.
- TD Cast and Crew members are expected to remain at their work location unless granted permission to leave for a specific reason by one of the adults in charge.
- TD Cast and Crew are not to be present in parts of the school other than their assigned work locations, the contiguous workspaces, or restrooms.
- Violating the terms this Behavior Contact can be addressed through meetings with the TD staff members, the student's parents, and/or the School Administration. Repeat or egregious violators may be suspended or dismissed from TD.
